### **Dr. Thomas Schelling**

Professor of Foreign Affairs, National Security, Nuclear Strategy, and Arms Control at the University of Maryland

Dr. Schelling earned his Ph.D. from Harvard, and was awarded the Nobel Memorial Prize in Economics in 2005 for his work in conflict and cooperation through game-theory analysis. He served with the Marshall Plan in Europe, the White House, and the Executive Office of the President from 1948 to 1953. His book, *The Strategy of Conflict*, pioneered the study of bargaining and strategic behavior. Dr. Schelling has been involved in the global warming debate since 1980. He believes climate change poses a serious threat to developing nations, but that the threat to the United States has been exaggerated.

### **Lauren C. Templeton**

Founder and President of Lauren Templeton Capital Management, LLC

LTCM is an alternative investment firm located in Chattanooga, Tennessee which currently manages approximately \$160 million for high net worth individuals, endowments, and foundations. The company is the general partner to the LT Market Neutral Fund, the LT Low Volatility Fund, and the Global Maximum Pessimism Fund. In addition, Ms. Templeton is the president and founder of the Southeastern Hedge Fund Association, Inc., and serves on a variety of business and university organizations’ boards.

Ms. Templeton is also the great niece of Sir John M. Templeton, and co-author of the book *Investing the Templeton Way: The Market Beating Strategies of Value Investing’s Legendary Bargain Hunter*. Ms. Templeton graduated with a B.A. in Economics from the University of the South in 1998.

Managing Director & Principal, Tenth Street Capital Partners, LLC

Tenth Street Capital Partners, LLC makes investments in small to middle market companies in the form of mezzanine debt. Along with sustainable cash flow, these companies will generally have revenue between \$5 and \$50 million. The fund invests \$1 – 3 million per transaction, but has the ability to participate in larger transactions. The fund principally invests in service, manufacturing, and distribution businesses.

Mr. Duke is the former President of SunTrust Bank Chattanooga and the Livingston Company, a merchant bank. He brings nearly 30 years experience in direct lending and management in both commercial and mezzanine lending.

Mr. Duke received his bachelor’s degree from Davidson College and his MBA from Harvard Business School.
