

Advisement Program

UTC Department of Chemistry

The Chemistry Department provides academic advisement and career counseling for students who are majoring in chemistry or are taking chemistry courses as a primary component of a pre-professional program (such as Pre-Pharmacy). Prior to signing up for the next semester of classes, each student will schedule an advisement session, at which the advisor will discuss the student's course of study and give the student an Alternate PIN code for registration. This code changes each semester and students must meet with an academic advisor to receive it.

Freshman chemistry majors will be assigned an advisor in the Center for Advisement and Student Success in the University Center and will receive their Alternate PIN codes there. In addition, students are encouraged to see the appropriate chemistry advisor below, especially those who are pre-professional.
