Dear English Major,

The English Department Scholarships Committee invites you to apply for the following six scholarships specifically designated for English majors: the Arlie E. Herron Scholarship, the Sally B. Young Scholarship, the Marian J. Tyte Scholarship, the Robert W. and Beatrice R. Anderson Scholarship, Chuck Pierce Scholarship, and the Dr. Margaret N. Kelley Scholarship. Please find the application attached.

**About the scholarships, and eligibility:**

- Arlie E. Herron scholarship -- to be awarded to a full-time junior, senior, or graduate English major with at least a 2.5 cumulative GPA and a minimum 3.0 GPA in the major. This scholarship was established in 1999 by UTC Professors Verbie Provost and Fran Bender to honor Prof. Emeritus Arlie Herron who served the English Department, UTC, and the Chattanooga Community for 39 years as a member of the UTC faculty.
- Sally B. Young Scholarship-- to be awarded to a full or part-time, junior, senior or graduate English major with a 3.0 cumulative GPA or higher and a minimum 3.5 GPA in the major. This scholarship was established in 2001 by Larry Young to memorialize his wife, UTC English Professor, Sally Burton Young.
- Marian J. Tyte Scholarship-- to be awarded to a full or part-time English major, including graduate students; special consideration shall be given to parents continuing their education while also caring for their children. Marian Jones Tyte, a member of the UTC class of 1930, had a strong interest in Theatre and English, and her husband, The Reverend Wilbur H. Tyte, established this scholarship in her memory.
- Chuck Pierce Scholarship-- to be awarded to a full-time English major, including graduate students, returning to UTC after an absence of at least one year, with at least a 3.0 cumulative GPA in the last UTC semester and a 3.25 GPA in the major. Charles "Chuck" Pierce was the son of UTC Alumni and active university volunteers, Charles and Rickie Pierce, who established this scholarship to honor the memory of their son who passed away prematurely at age 31.
- Dr. Margaret N. Kelley Graduate Scholarship in English-- to be awarded to a graduate student majoring in English. This scholarship was established in 2007 by Ronald D. and Janet Kelley Jobe in honor of their mother-in-law and mother who worked in the Development Office and as a Vice Chancellor for Advancement at The University of Tennessee at Chattanooga from 1983 until her retirement in 2007.
- Robert W. and Beatrice R. Anderson Scholarship-- to be awarded to a full or part-time, English major with a 3.0 cumulative GPA or higher and a minimum 3.5 GPA in the major. This scholarship was established in 2002 by John R. Anderson, Class of 1978 and past Alumni Council president and trustee of the University of Chattanooga Foundation, in honor of his parents Robert W. and Beatrice R. Anderson.
- All six awards will be dispersed in equal installments at the 2012/2013 Fall and Spring registration.

Actual scholarship amounts will depend upon the year's earnings for these funds. Upon receipt of the application (including your Letter of Interest), the English Department Scholarships Committee will automatically consider you for any of the six scholarships for which you are

eligible. However, if you qualify to be considered for any particular scholarship, include that explanation in your letter.
