

DESCRIPTION (www.utc.edu/gatp/entry)

The University of Tennessee at Chattanooga (UTC) offers a CAATE accredited, graduate Athletic Training Education Program (ATEP) in the Department of Health and Human Performance. We are currently transitioning to a degree designation of a Master of Science in Athletic Training (expected to be effective fall 2008).



Students who have completed a bachelor's degree from a regionally accredited four-year institution, and who have completed the six pre-requisite courses, are eligible for consideration for admission to the UTC ATEP. Currently, we do not require a specific undergraduate degree for program admission, but a strong background in basic sciences is desirable.

This full-time, two-year academic program provides athletic training students with an effective blend of evidence-based didactic information, clinical experiences for skill and theory integration, and clinical epidemiology-based research. The ATEP thoroughly addresses the NATA Athletic Training Educational Competencies (4th ed) in compliance with CAATE accreditation standards and Board of Certification (BOC) requirements. Additionally, the program emphasizes advanced theoretical, clinical and research skills essential for working with the physiological, and biomechanical aspects of injury, illness, and performance of physically active populations.
