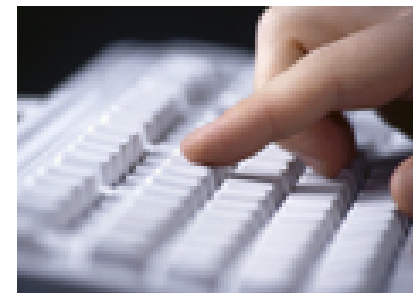

About the program

The Master of Public Administration program at UTC offers the Certificate in Nonprofit Management.

This program is aimed at providing nonprofit managers and leaders, and those who aspire to such positions, with knowledge regarding the efficient, effective, and ethical management of nonprofit agencies. Courses are offered totally online with no on campus visits required. Students may enter the certificate program in either the fall or spring semester.

Admissions Qualifications

Students may qualify for admission into the Certificate in Nonprofit Management program in either one of the following two ways:

Fulfill the following requirements:

Hold a bachelor's degree

Have significant related experience

Demonstrate writing ability by taking a writing proficiency exam.

OR

Hold a Masters degree in a relevant discipline from a regionally accredited university.

Course Objectives
