The university requires **60 hours at a 4 yr. university/college**, and the **last 24 credit hours completed at UTC**.

*Second baccalaureate degree students do not have to meet university (general education) requirements but must have a C or better in the non-nursing course requirements for the BSN degree. Nursing course requirements are indicated above with an asterisk.

A current RN license shows that RN students have passed NCLEX and is used to give credit for 27 hours of Adult, Maternal/Child, and Psychiatric Nursing at the 300-400 level. The hours will be entered in the student's academic record as P (pass) the semester of graduation. These hours will count toward the university's requirement of 60 hours at a 4 year school but will not count as part of the last 24 hours at UTC. You may take classes outside UTC only if you do NOT violate these policies (last 24 hr. rule, 60 hr. rule, at least 39 hrs. at 300-400 level, and at least 25% of classes/credit hours to be taken under direction of the UTC faculty).
