



Edinburgh Global Master's & Homecoming Scotland Scholarships

Eligibility

Applicants must have been offered admission to pursue a Master's degree programme of study at the University of Edinburgh commencing in the 2010-2011 academic session on a full-time basis.

The Homecoming Scotland Scholarships are open to those liable to pay tuition fees at the overseas rate, while the Edinburgh Global Scholarships are open to students from certain eligible countries.

Structure of the Scholarship

Ten Homecoming Scotland Scholarships each with a value of £5,000, and twenty Global Scholarships each with a value of £3,000 are available.

The scholarships are tenable for one year. The scholarships must be taken-up in 2010-2011. A scholarship holder, who subsequently defers admission until the start of the 2011-2012 session, or any later date, will automatically be required to surrender their scholarship.

Criterion for Award

The sole criterion for the award of the scholarships will be academic excellence. Successful candidates will normally have, or be expected to obtain, a first class or 2:1 Honours degree at undergraduate level or equivalent.

Application and Selection Procedure

All applications must be made online using the scholarship online application form obtainable on the University of Edinburgh's Scholarships & Student Finance Office website.
