

ADMISSION TO THE TEACHER EDUCATION PROGRAM FOR UNDERGRADUATE STUDENTS AND POST-BACCALAUREATE NON-DEGREE STUDENTS

--To access a TEP application, go to the UTC website and choose the site index. Choose Teacher Preparation Academy, and then choose forms and applications

Prerequisite Coursework:

- EDUC 201 (all education students)
- HECO-242 (secondary and middle grade students)
- EDUC-323 (special education and early childhood students)

GPA Requirements:

- 2.5 cumulative GPA
- 2.5 GPA on all courses taken at UTC
- 2.5 GPA on all professional courses with no grade lower than C
- 2.5 GPA in content area courses with no grade lower than C

Steps for Admission to TEP:

Submit the completed application, signed by your advisor, along with a current RAP sheet, to Jan Gould in Hunter Hall, Room 204.

Submit the completed:

- resume, including:
 - name, address
 - degree status and major(s)
 - employment history
 - other information (volunteer work, honors, etc.)
- essay –see Jan Gould in Hunter Hall, Room 204 for an appointment.

Submit student evaluation forms from field placements in Education 201 and HECO 242 or Education 323 (if required in your program).

Submit alternative documentation of completion of early field experiences if you received transfer credit for a field placement course.

Submit proof of fingerprinting.

Submit an application for the interview. **Interviews will not be scheduled unless the admission file is complete and you have been fingerprinted.**
