Prerequisite Coursework:

EDUC 521

GPA Requirements:

2.5 cumulative GPA
2.5 on bridging* courses with no grade lower than C
3.0 on graduate education courses
*or alternatives which fulfill program requirements

Test Score Requirements:

Praxis I: Math (173), Reading (174), and Writing (173)

Steps for Admission to TEP:

Submit the completed application, signed by your advisor, to Jan Gould in Hunter Hall Room 204.

Submit the completed:

- resume, including
 - name, address
 - degree status and major(s)
 - employment history
 - other information (volunteer work, honors, etc.)

Submit an essay; see Jan Gould in Hunter Hall for an appointment.

Submit student evaluation forms from field placements in Education 520 and 521.

Submit proof of fingerprinting.

Submit an application for the interview. **Interviews will not be scheduled unless the admission file is complete and you have been fingerprinted.**
