RESPONSIBILITIES: This is a nine-month, full-time, tenure-track appointment that requires teaching and supervising research at the doctoral level and some teaching at the master's level.

QUALIFICATIONS: The successful candidate will hold an earned doctorate (Ph.D., or equivalent) in psychology, business, other social sciences or education from an accredited doctoral granting institution. The candidate will have experience with doctoral-level programs, including research design and methodology, and will present an established record of research and/or a specific background in learning systems theory. The successful candidate will show evidence of experience and scholarship in one or more of the following areas: assessment, research, performance improvement, or finance.

ADDITIONAL QUALIFICATIONS: The preferred candidate will have experience in the dissertation process and will show evidence of a broad understanding and skill in instructional technology (synchronous and asynchronous).
