**Position Description:**

The University of Tennessee at Chattanooga (UTC) School of Nursing invites applications and nominations for a nine month faculty position. Requirements include a Masters Degree in Nursing and either a Doctorate of Nursing Practice or PhD in Nursing or a related field. National Certification is required. Must be capable of teaching relevant graduate level courses in the School of Nursing graduate program. The successful candidate will be responsible for advising students in Scholarly Translation Research Projection and evaluating student progress in research work. In addition, the successful candidate will be able to conduct independent and collaborative research with a clinical focus and to publish in nationally recognized journals. Ability to establish a program of research with external funding is desirable.
