

# CHAIR OF EXCELLENCE IN APPLIED MATHEMATICS

The Department of Mathematics at the University of Tennessee at Chattanooga (UTC) invites nominations and applications for the position of

## UNUM CHAIR OF EXCELLENCE IN APPLIED MATHEMATICS.

This is an endowed chair that also carries its own budget for travel, secretarial support, and other operating expenses. The successful candidate will have an international research reputation in the mathematics community, a demonstrated record of attracting funding, experience in outreach activities, and a record of excellence in teaching at the undergraduate and graduate levels, appropriate for a tenurable appointment as Associate or Full Professor. A Ph.D. is required. The Chair is expected to be actively involved in advancing the mission of the Department and the University. The appointment begins August 1, 2012.

The Department of Mathematics at UTC offers the B.A. in Mathematics, the B.S. in Applied Mathematics, and the M.S. in Mathematics. There are currently 70 majors in addition to 11 Secondary Mathematics Majors and 11 fulltime graduate students. There are 18 tenured and tenure-track faculty in addition to 4 visiting professors and 9 full time lecturers.

UTC is a metropolitan institution, one of four primary campuses of the University of Tennessee, and has an enrollment of 9900 undergraduate and 1500 graduate students. Its 100-acre campus is located in Chattanooga, a mid-sized city that has been featured in US News and World Report and Parade as one of America's most livable cities. The campus is in the revitalized downtown area and has been an integral partner in the nationally recognized renaissance of Chattanooga. The university's private endowment, currently valued at more than \$100 million, enables UTC to maintain academic excellence beyond that funded by state appropriations.

Applications from women and minorities are especially encouraged. Screening of applicants will begin February 15, 2012 and will continue until the position is filled.

In addition to a curriculum vitae and other supporting documents, applicants should submit a statement of philosophy and vision for this position and arrange for four letters of recommendation.
