

# UTC Mathematics Lecturer

The Department of Mathematics at the University of Tennessee at Chattanooga (UTC) invites applications for the following Lecturer position for 2012-13, all of which are subject to final budget approval. UTC is a metropolitan institution, one of four primary campuses of the University of Tennessee, and has an enrollment of 9900 undergraduate and 1500 graduate students. Its 100-acre campus is located in Chattanooga, a mid-sized city that has been featured in US News and World Report and Parade as one of America's most livable cities. This family-friendly city has gained international attention for its downtown and riverfront development, public and private partnerships, excellent quality of life, and reasonable cost of living. The campus is in the revitalized downtown area and has been an integral partner in the nationally recognized renaissance of Chattanooga. The university's private endowment, currently valued at more than \$100 million, enables UTC to maintain academic excellence beyond that funded by state appropriations.

**LECTURERS:** Minimum requirements include a Master's degree in Mathematics or in a closely related area with a minimum of 18 hours of graduate level Mathematics courses. A Ph.D. is preferred. The position requires teaching 12 hours per semester in addition to serving on committees and participating in the overall education effort of the Department. The successful candidate must have a record of excellence in teaching preferably at the college level. These are one year positions but they are renewable.

Applications from women and minorities are especially encouraged. Screening of all applicants will begin January 15, 2012, and will continue until all positions are filled. In addition to submitting an AMS Standard Cover Sheet, a curriculum vitae, an unofficial transcript, and other supporting documents, applicants should arrange for three letters of recommendation to be addressed to Professor Ronald Smith, Chair of the Hiring Committee.
