POSITION: Associate Professor and Department Head, Social Work Department

EFFECTIVE DATE: July 1, 2012
This is a 12-month, full-time, tenure-track appointment.

RESPONSIBILITIES: This position is responsible for the day-to-day leadership and management of the Social Work Department, serving approximately 100 undergraduate students and five full-time faculty and staff. Responsibilities include planning instructional delivery and program development, and providing leadership to full- and part-time faculty in instruction, research, and community service. The leader will help maintain accreditation standards, manage the budget, and represent the program on campus and in the community. The Social Work Department Head reports to the Dean of the College of Health, Education and Professional Studies. The social work program is accredited by the Council on Social Work Education (CSWE).

QUALIFICATIONS: Candidates must hold the M.S.W. and a doctorate in social work or a related field. The ideal candidate will possess social work practice experience and academic experience. This position requires excellent teaching skills, evidence of scholarly achievement, and academic leadership.

APPLICATION: Screening of applications will begin on December 1, 2011 and continue until the position is filled. Applicants should submit a letter of interest, a curriculum vita, official transcripts of all post-secondary academic work, and the names, phone numbers and addresses of at least three references to facultyvitae09@utc.edu.
