

What do you need to be admitted to UTC? REQUIREMENTS

Admissions Requirements

All freshmen under 21 years of age must graduate with a regular diploma from an accredited or state approved high school or complete a GED.

Regular Admission

All first-time freshmen applying for admission to the University of Tennessee at Chattanooga must meet one of the following high school grade point average and ACT/SAT combinations:

- 2.75 high school GPA (on a 4.0 scale) and a minimum 17 ACT composite (830 SAT composite)
- or
- 21 ACT composite (990 SAT composite) and a minimum 2.0 high school GPA (on a 4.0 scale)

In addition to meeting the GPA and ACT/SAT requirements, a first-time freshman must have the following minimum unit requirements:

- 4 units of English
- 2 units of laboratory science
- 1 unit of European history, world history, or world geography
- 3 units of math (algebra I, algebra II, and geometry)
- 1 unit of American history
- 2 units of the same foreign language
- 1 unit of visual or performing arts

Exceptions to Regular Admission Requirements

A limited number of students who do not meet the regular admission standards may be admitted to UTC by petition to the Admissions Office. The deadlines for submission of these petitions will be August 1 for fall semester and December 1 for spring semester respectively.

For exceptions to regular admission, the admissions committee may recommend one or all of the following conditions:

- reduced course load
- specific academic advisor
- specific course requirements
- specific program of developmental studies

- Begin on-line application for on-campus housing
- \$25 non-refundable application fee (separate from admission application fee)
- After e-mail notification of room assignment, please pay a \$225 reservation fee in order to confirm the room assignment
 - For residents of UTC Place, a \$125 reservation fee must be paid **before** room assignment.
- Choose a meal plan

Five Steps to Financial Aid

1. Complete and e-Sign the FAFSA on the web.
2. Submit all requested documents to the Financial Aid Office.
3. Accept your financial aid awards via your MocsNet account.
4. Got loans? Complete all loan-related requirements.
5. Accept your charges with the Bursar's Office, in 1 of 3 ways:
 - through your MocsNet account,
 - by returning your Mocs Express statement mailed to you, or
 - by calling the Bursar at (423) 425-4781.
