

# What is GOLD?



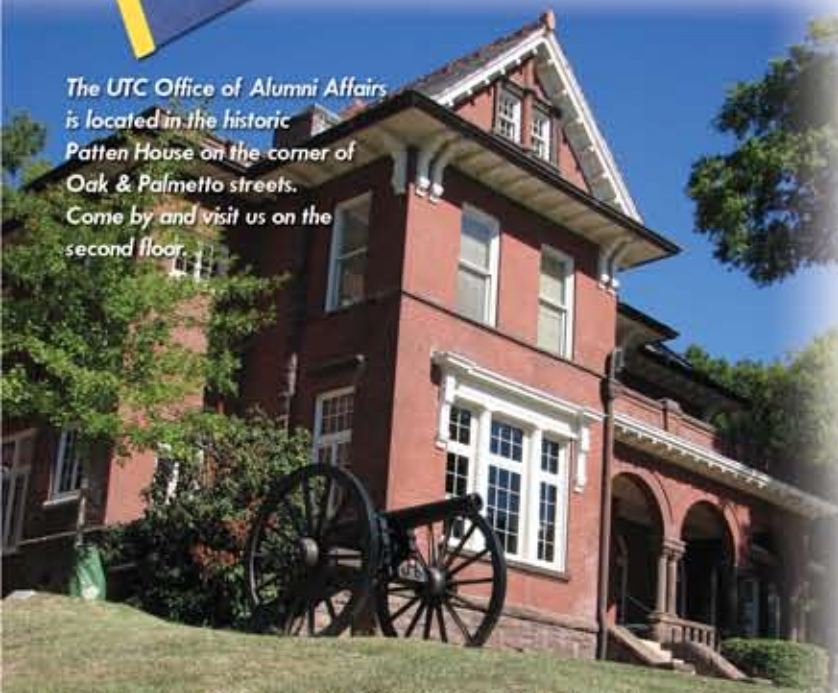
## Grads of the Last Decade

Gold encompasses all alumni of UTC who have graduated, or passed at least 24 semester hours from the university within ten years of the most recent graduating class. GOLD = Grads Of the Last Decade.

At UTC, over 13,000 alumni are graduates of the last ten years, and this number is growing larger with every graduating class. Because of this large number and the fact that our young alumni represent an abundance of virtually untapped resources of energy and enthusiasm, the GOLD program was established to provide an opportunity for more organized participation and leadership for this segment of the UTC alumni base.
