

## UTC Departmental Honors Deadline 2009 – 2010 Academic Year

### APPLICANTS

Submitting a proposal during Fall 2009 to begin DHON in Spring 2010 (including those who plan to graduate in August 2010 or December 2010) who have not submitted yet. It is **STRONGLY** recommend that any students who expect to register for DHON in the summer (which is not recommended) propose in the Fall.

- Draft of proposal must be turned into Joanie Sompayrac no later than Friday, September 25, 2009.
- Final proposal must be emailed to [dhon@utc.edu](mailto:dhon@utc.edu) no later than Friday, October 9, 2009.

Submitting a proposal during Spring 2010 to begin DHON in Summer 2010 or Fall 2010:

- Draft of proposal must be turned into Joanie Sompayrac no later than Friday, February 12, 2010.
- Final proposal must be emailed to [dhon@utc.edu](mailto:dhon@utc.edu) no later than Friday, February 26, 2010.

### CANDIDATES in *first* semester of 495 during Fall 2009

Progress Report with Full Examination Committee  
At least one (1) week prior to the last day of classes

NOTE: This **MUST** be done no later than Monday, November 23, 2009, which is the Monday before Thanksgiving, so students may want to schedule this meeting earlier than the deadline.

Final draft of complete project due to Examination Committee at least one (1) week prior to the oral exam date.

No later than Monday, March 22, 2010

Oral Examination must take place at least Three (3) weeks prior to the last day of classes

No later than Monday, March 29, 2010

Three final copies of the DHON thesis with any prescribed revisions **MUST** Be turned into Joanie Sompayrac at least two (2) weeks before the last day of classes. ***If you do not turn in your project, you may not receive a grade for your work DHON!***

No later than Monday, April 5, 2010.

### CANDIDATES in *second* semester of 495 during Fall 2009

Final draft of complete project due to Examination Committee at least one (1) week prior to the oral exam date.

No later than Monday, November 2, 2009.

Oral Examination must take place at least Three (3) weeks prior to the last day of classes

No later than Monday, November 9, 2009.

Three final copies of the DHON thesis with any prescribed revisions **MUST** Be turned into Joanie Sompayrac at least two (2) weeks before the last day of classes. ***If you do not turn in your project, you may not receive a grade for your work DHON!***

No later than Monday, November 16, 2009.

### CANDIDATES in *first* semester of 495 during Spring 2010

Progress Report with Full Examination Committee  
At least one (1) week prior to the last day of classes

No later than Monday, April 12, 2010

Final draft of complete project due to Examination Committee at least one (1) week prior to the oral exam date.

No later than Monday, November 7, 2010

Oral Examination must take place at least Three (3) weeks prior to the last day of classes

No later than Monday, November 15, 2010

Three final copies of the DHON thesis with any prescribed revisions **MUST** Be turned into Joanie Sompayrac at least two (2) weeks before the last day of classes. ***If you do not turn in your project, you may not receive a grade for your work DHON!***

No later than Monday, November 22, 2010
