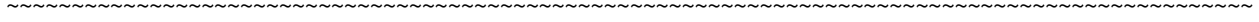

Calendar Requirements for Proposed Full Summer Term

- Term to be 12 weeks
- 60 Weekdays/58 Class Days (Memorial Day and Independence Day)
- MT have 11 meeting days (because of Memorial Day and Independence Day)
- WTHF have 12 meeting days
- 3 hour classes would meet for 90 minutes two days per week for a total of 2070 minutes
- 4 hour classes would meet for 90 minutes two days per week with a 90 minute lab in addition to lecture meeting time (either a third meeting day or 2nd 90 minute session on a day following one of the lectures)
- Standard 90 minute blocks would be a very easy way to schedule classes in an unconventional term and allow overlap with mini terms to allow students to take classes in a full term or mini term
- Last day to drop with a W – last Friday in June

**Calendar Requirements for Proposed First Mini Summer Term**

- Term to be 6 weeks
- 30 Weekdays/29 Class days (Memorial Day)
- Classes meet 5 days per week
- 3 hour classes would meet for 75 minutes each day for a total of 2175 minutes
- 4 hour classes would meet for 75 minutes each day with an additional two day per week 75 minute lab
- 3 hours classes could meet two days per week (MW meet 11 times or TTH meet 12 times) for 180 or 190 minutes beginning at 5:00p or 5:30p (MW 180/1980; 190/2090) (TTH 180/2160; 190/2280)
- Final exams would be administered on the last day of class
- Last day to drop with a "W" – end of 4<sup>th</sup> week of class

Calendar Requirements for Proposed Second Mini Summer Term

- Term to be 6 weeks
- 30 Weekdays/29 Class Days (Independence Day)
- Classes meet 5 days per week
- 3 hour classes would meet for 75 minutes each day for a total of 2175 minutes
- 4 hour classes would meet for 75 minutes each day with an additional two day per week 75 minute lab
- 3 hours classes could meet two days per week (MW meet 11 times or TTH meet 12 times) for 180 or 190 minutes beginning at 5:00p or 5:30p (MW 180/1980; 190/2090) (TTH 180/2160; 190/2280)
- Final exams would be administered on the last day of class
- July 4th – floating holiday – next year the MW classes would meet 11 times and the TTH would meet 12 times
- Last day to drop with a "W" – end of 4th week of class
