Resolution from the Faculty Senate, University of Tennessee at Chattanooga

Mathematics is an intellectual skill that requires continual practice to master, and students who postpone their General Education and major field mathematics courses are less likely to be successful in these courses.

Therefore, the Faculty Senate would like to support the Department of Mathematics by requesting that all academic advisors

1. Encourage entering and transfer students to enroll in appropriate mathematics courses as a part of their first year experience.
2. Encourage students to enroll in the appropriate mathematics course to meet their General Education and major field requirements each semester until their mathematics requirements are completed.
