The Parliamentarian's Role

- Purely advisory role
 - To advise the President in responding to POIs
 - Provide advice on conducting meetings
- Does not make rulings!**
 - Only the President may rule

Topic	Second?	Debatable?	Amendable?	Vote
Adjourn	yes (Takes priority)	no	no	majority
Amendment	yes	yes	yes, <u>once</u>	majority

- Only two amendments may be considered at a time. They are voted on in reverse order, i.e. the second is voted on first. If a third is proposed the second must be disposed of to reduce the active number of amendments to two.
- Friendly amendment: not in RRoO; informally accepted if it affects only wording and not the thrust of the motion.

by order of the Chair if no objection, or requires 2/3 vote

Chair voting				
Normally the Chair does not vote but may if the vote will affect the outcome of a motion, i.e. to make or break a tie. Forcing a tie will defeat a motion since a majority is required.				
Debate				
Everyone wishing to speak is allowed to before anyone (except the proposer answering questions about the motion) speaks a second time. A time limit may be agreed to, which requires a 2/3 vote. Debate may not begin until the motion has been moved and seconded.

Divide the Assembly		(not debatable)		(show of hands on vote)
requested by at least one member

■ Limit/Extend/End debate	yes	no	yes	2/3
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● If the question is called the Chair may ask if there is any objection to voting. If not voting proceeds; otherwise a count is required. 				
■ Point of Order				
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Chair decides, may be appealed (see above) 				
■ Postpone Debate	yes	yes	yes	majority
■ Quorum				
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● majority= 50% + 1

■ Reconsider	yes	yes*	no	majority
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Must be moved by someone who voted with the prevailing side in the previous vote, held that meeting or one previous ● * If the original motion was debatable 				
■ Receive a report				
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● no vote needed, presenting it verbally or in writing is receiving it 				
■ Secret ballot				
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Allowed in General Faculty meetings by UTC bylaws if requested by more than 1 member, or in the Faculty Senate if requested by ¼ of those present 				
■ Substitute motion				
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Is treated as an <u>amendment</u>

■ Table motion	yes	no	no	majority
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Proposer or designee may speak for two minutes on behalf of the motion to Table. It must be taken from the Table at the next meeting. The intent is to kill the motion; it is different from Commit. 				
■ Take from the Table	yes	no	no	majority
■ Withdraw motion				
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● If no objection
