Individual instruction for students with limited applied music experience. Will not be accepted as applied credit for any music degree program or Performance Music Minor. Every semester. For 1 hour credit, student will receive a 30-minute lesson. For 2 hours credit, student will receive a 1-hour lesson. Prerequisite: audition. Department head approval is required to register for the 1-hour lesson. Music course fee will be assessed.
