

Scholarships

Academic-year Ambassadorial Scholarship: A flat grant of \$23,000 for one academic year of study in another country. These awards help defray costs associated with round-trip transportation, tuition, fees, room and board and some educational supplies.

Cultural Ambassadorial Scholarship: Helps finance either three or six months of intensive language study and cultural immersion in another country. It provides a flat grant of \$10,000 for three months and \$15,000 for six months. Funds are intended to offset costs associated with roundtrip transportation, language training and home stay living arrangements.

Applications are considered for candidates interested in studying Arabic, English, French, German, Hebrew, Italian, Japanese, Korean, Mandarin Chinese, Polish, Portuguese, Russian, Spanish, Swahili and Swedish.

Eligibility Requirements:

- At least two years of college or equivalent professional experiences.
- Applications through Rotary Club where permanent residence is maintained.
- No direct association with Rotarians, Rotary employees.
- Proficiency in language of host country.
- Cultural Ambassadorial Scholars must have completed at least one year of college level language course of host country.
