

GPA Projection Calculator

To complete a graduate degree at UTC, a student must have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher on all graduate courses attempted and also a GPA of 3.0 or higher on all graduate courses that make up the entire program of study (including courses not listed on the Program of Study form but later listed (or to be listed) on the Application for Graduation, Candidacy and Certificate form).

Step 1 Cumulative GPA History

- a) As noted on the calculator, if you are new student and have no graduate course credit hours, you should enter zero '0' for the cumulative GPA hours and cumulative GPA. Do not enter your undergraduate hours or GPA, the GPA history section is for graduate course hours only, not undergraduate hours or undergraduate GPA.
- b) If you are a student who has graduate course credit hours, enter the cumulative graduate hours and the cumulative GPA for those hours. The Future Coursework section can be used to calculate the cumulative GPA for previous courses if you do not have that information readily available. Once you have calculated the GPA you will need to record that information in the appropriate data block under Step 1 and clear the information in the Future Coursework section to continue the projection process.

Step 2 Future Coursework

- a) Enter the following information in the columns provided: Description (Course name, this is optional); Course credit hours and the grade value you anticipate receiving or hope to receive.
- b) The grade values for courses can be changed to determine how the change would affect the overall projected GPA displayed in Step 3.

Step 3 Results

- a) As information is posted in Step 2, the results will be displayed as cumulative credit hours, grade values, grade points and projected GPA.
- b) When the Projected GPA is a 3.00 or higher the number will be in white lettering on a black background. However, when the Projected GPA falls below a 3.00, then the lettering will be black on a red background. In addition, a statement will be displayed below the Projected GPA in red that will read, "You will NOT be in Good Academic Standing."
