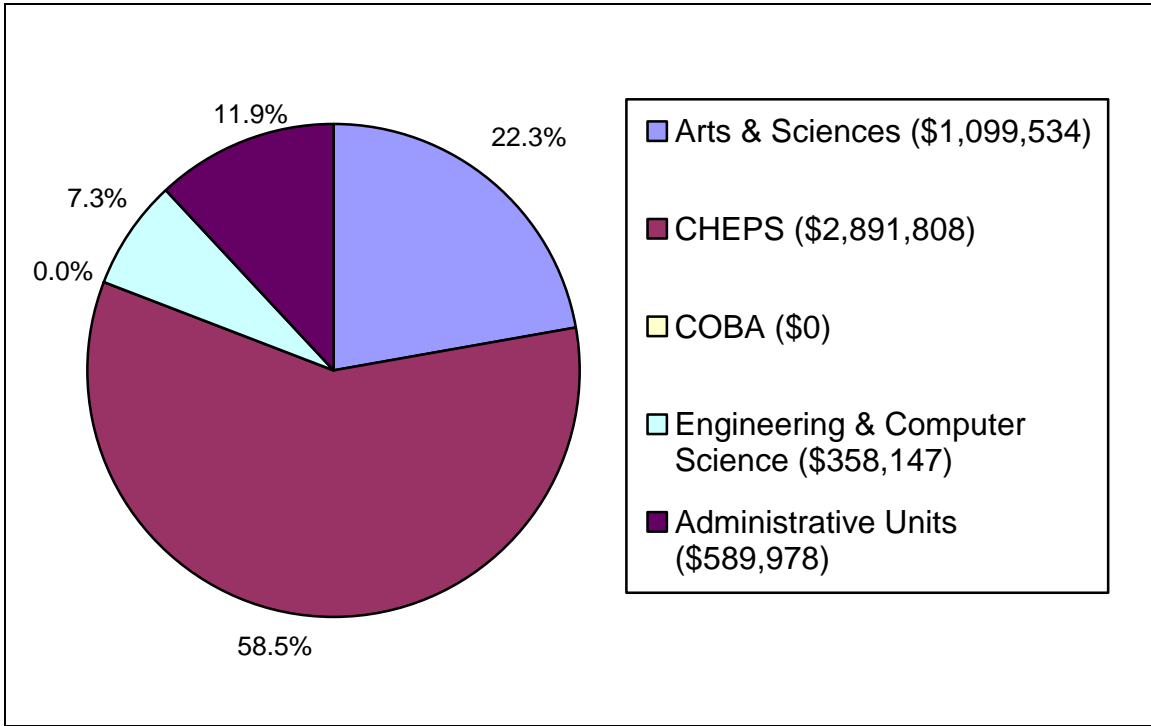

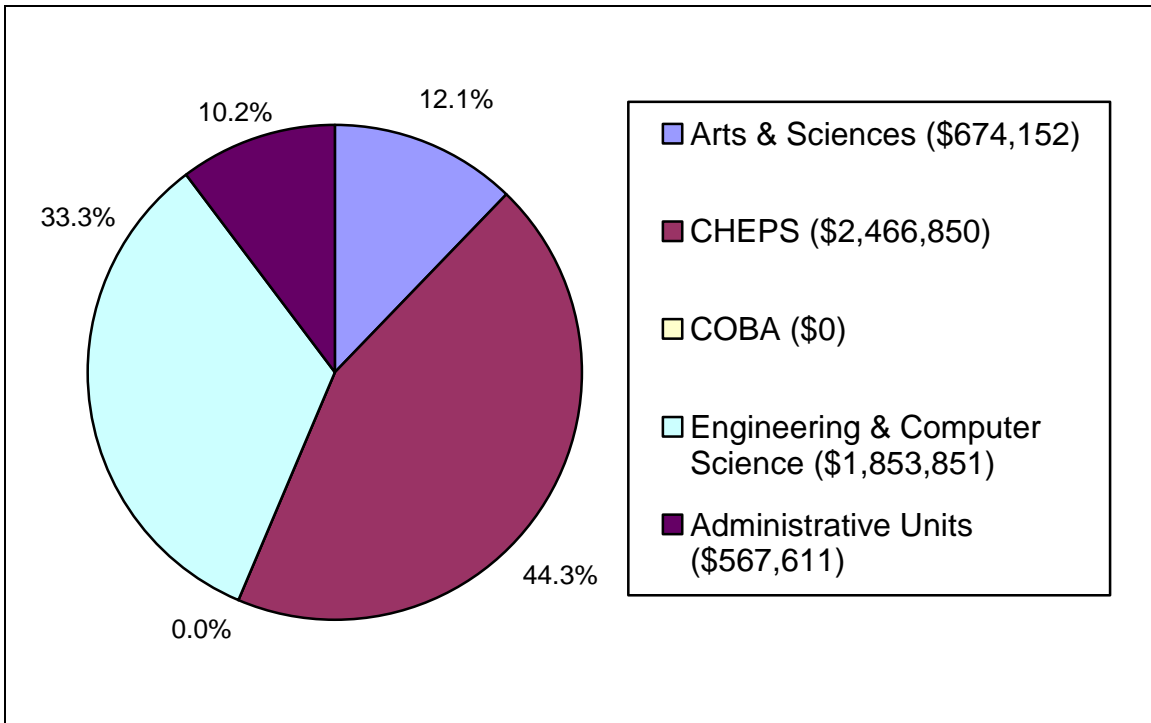

Comparison: July 1, 2007 – September 30, 2007

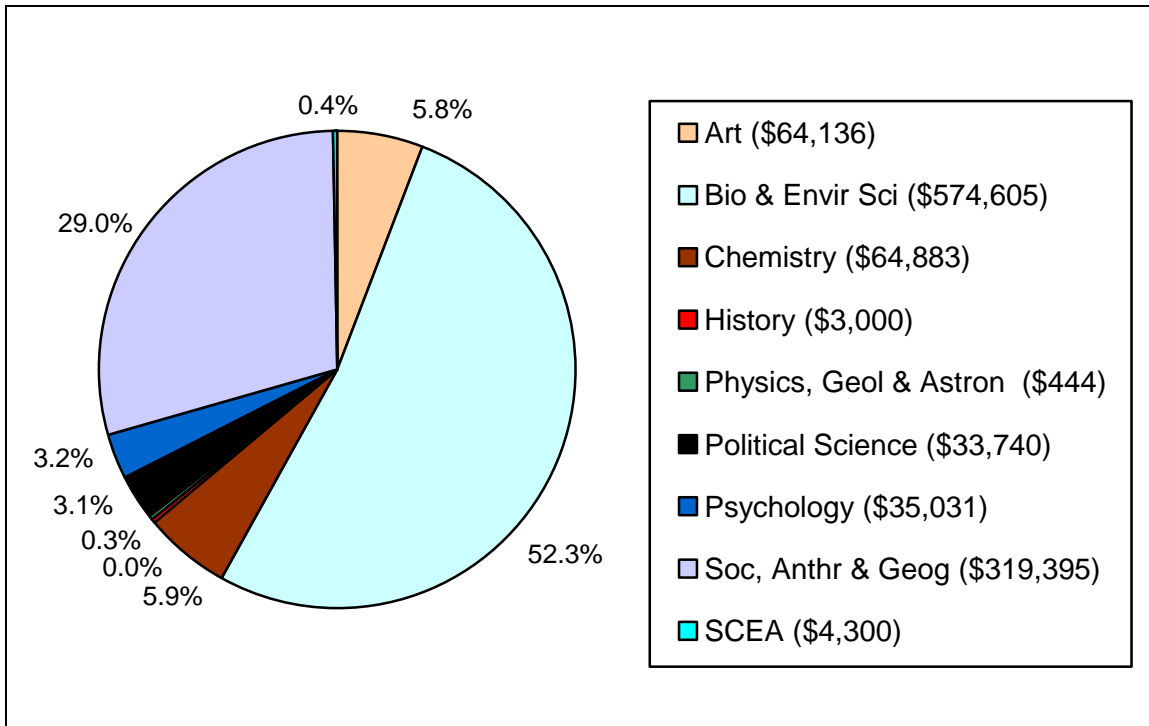
Total funding: \$5,562,464

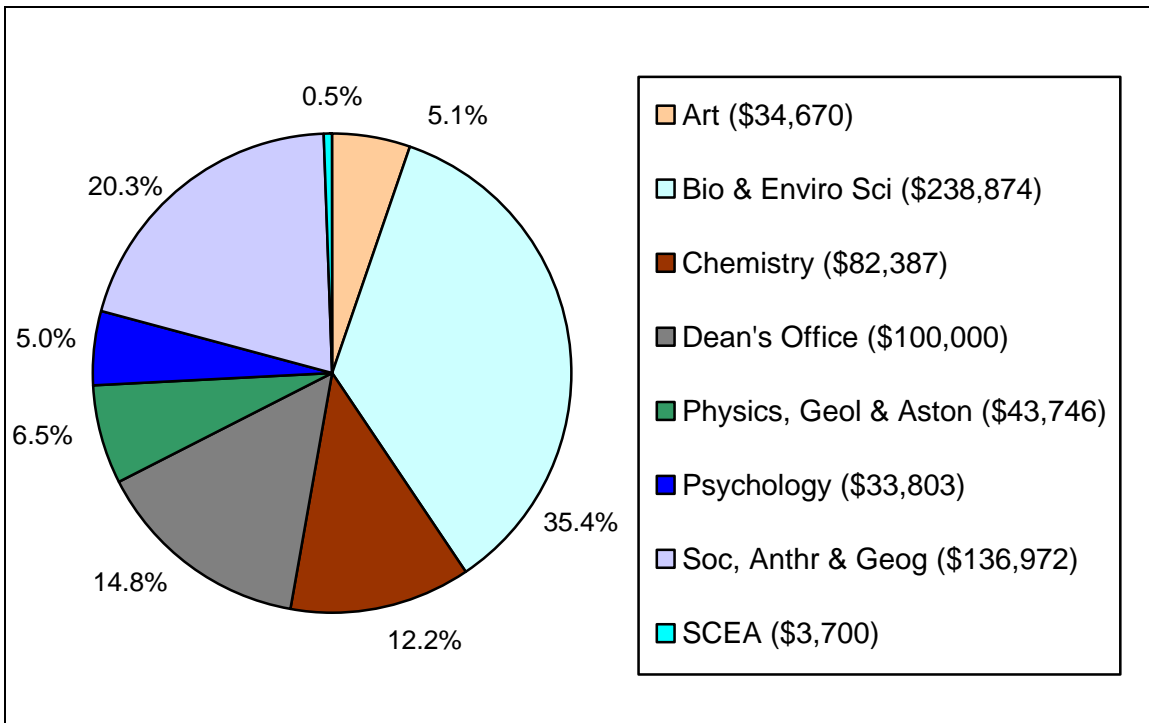
July 1, 2008 –September 30, 2008

Comparison: July 1, 2007 –September 30, 2007

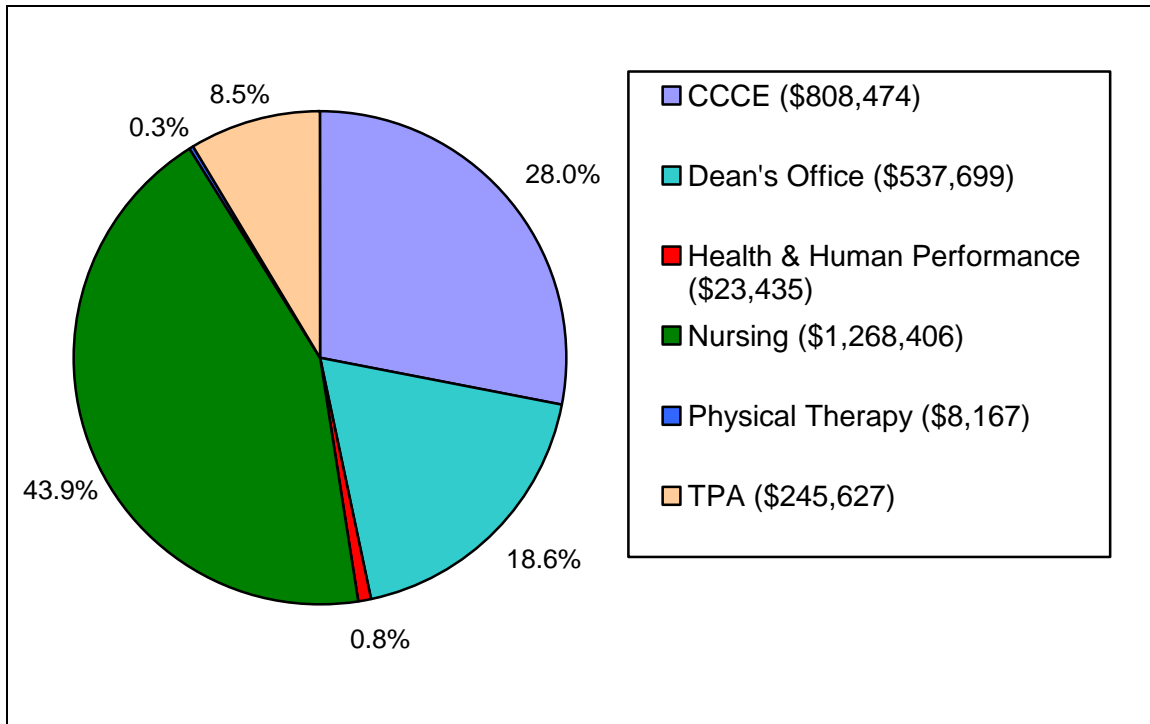

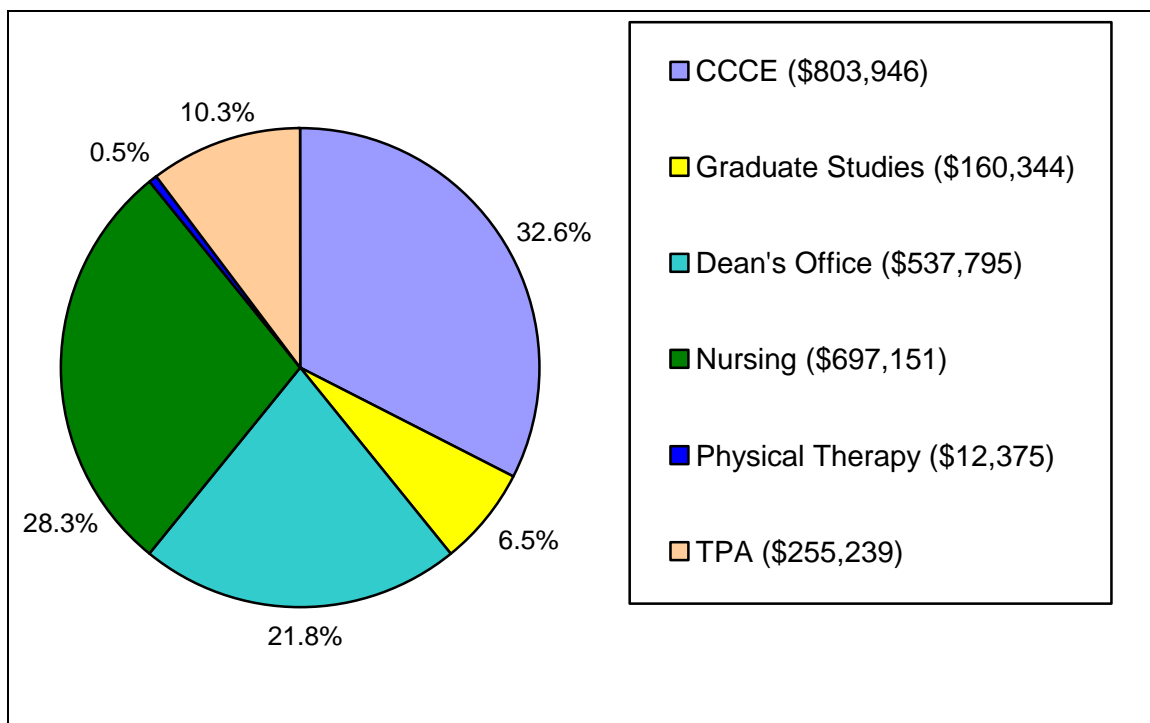

Comparison: July 1, 2007 – September 30, 2007

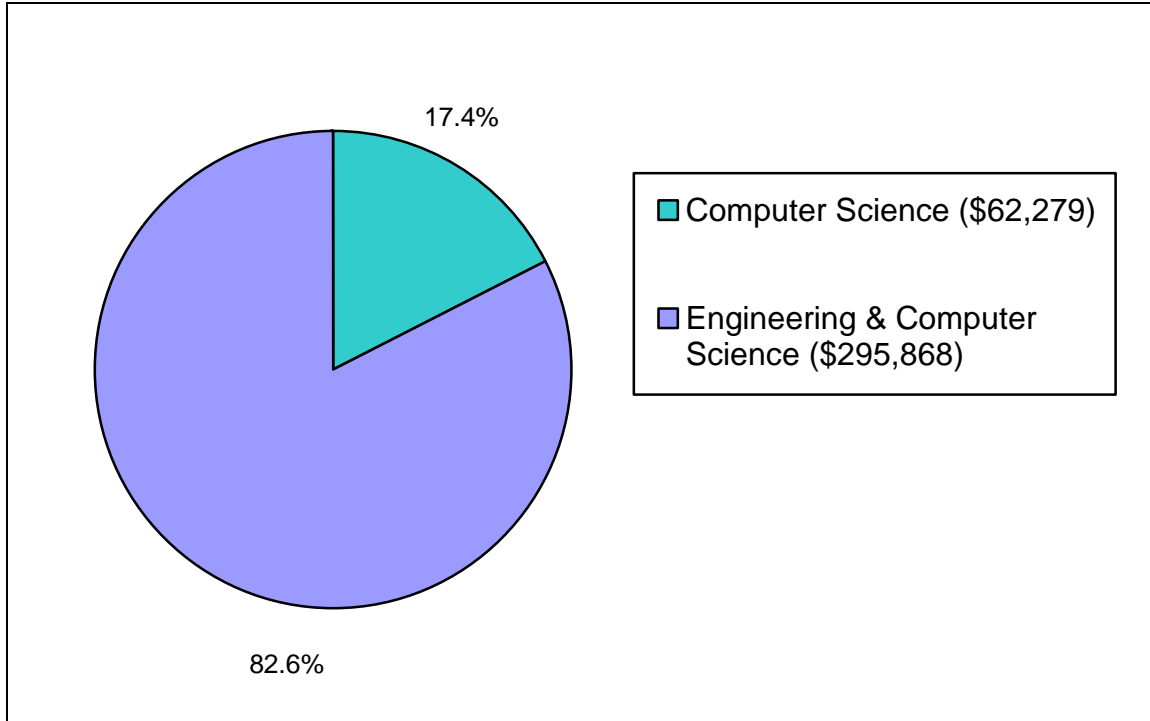

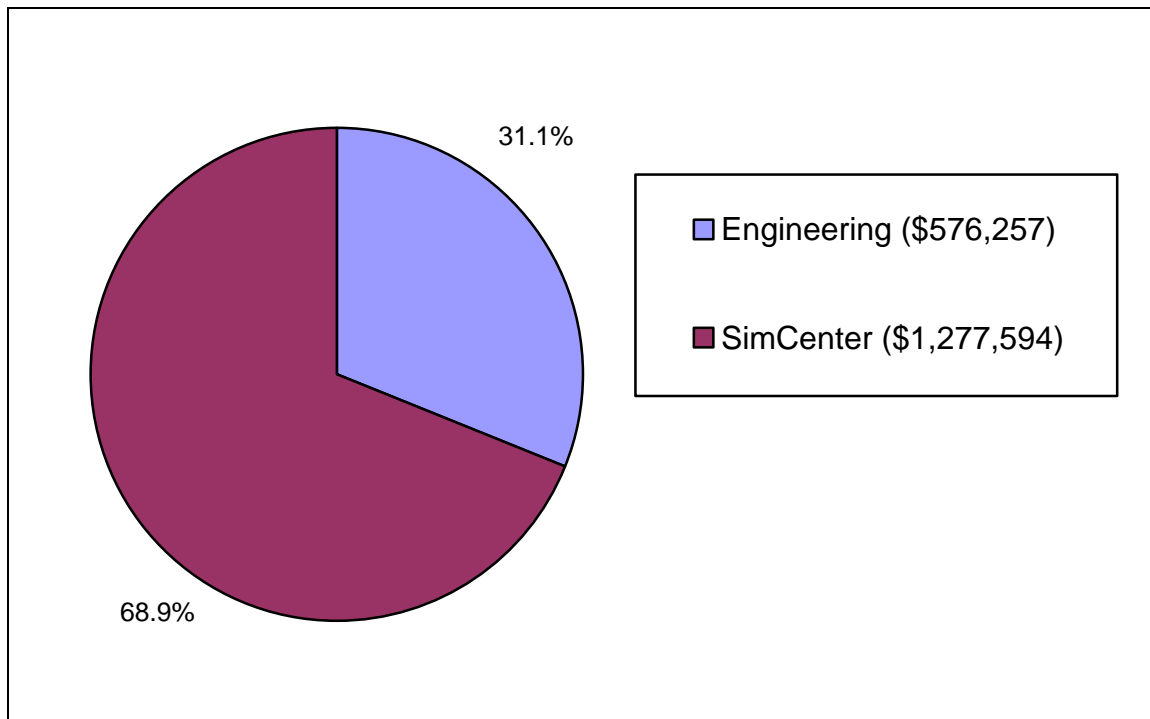
