Beginning in Fall 2010, race and ethnicity became self-reported categories in the application process.

Race and Hispanic origin are now considered separate categories in the new federal reporting guidelines. Persons who report themselves as Hispanic are reported only in the Hispanic category – regardless of race. Individuals who are not Hispanic and report themselves to be two or more races are reported in the two or more races, non-Hispanic category. All other individuals who do not report themselves to be of Hispanic origin are classified in one of the racial categories.
