Race and Hispanic origin are now considered separate categories in the new federal reporting guidelines. Persons who report themselves as Hispanic are reported only in the Hispanic category – regardless of race. Individuals who are not Hispanic and report themselves to be multi-racial are reported in the multi-racial, non-Hispanic category. All other individuals who do not report themselves to be of Hispanic origin are classified in one of the racial categories.
