# **Internet Access Services for the University**

### **Brief Description of the Project**

Five T1 circuits for Internet access by the campus.

The T1 services was replaced by a 30mbs circuit (a partial DS3) and a 4x improvement in Internet capacity with the same funding.

This is an annual recurring cost to maintain Internet access to the campus.
