Senior Division students (Grades 9-12) must complete checklist, Research Plan (1A), Research Plan Attachment, and Approval Form (1B) before work is begun. An abstract is required for all Senior Division students, preferably submitted with entry form. If not mailed with entry form, it should be submitted by registration or disqualification will result. Senior Division students must also submit additional forms for experiments involving animals, human subjects, tissue research, pathogenic agents, controlled substances, hazardous substances or devices, lasers, recombinant DNA, or Gasohol. These additional forms must be submitted to the Science Fair office for approval by the Scientific Review Committee prior to beginning work. All research requiring a Federal and/or State Permit will be expected to have the permit prior to the onset of the research. It must also be submitted with entry blank. The complete ISEF certifications must be mailed with the entry blank, if not mailed earlier.
