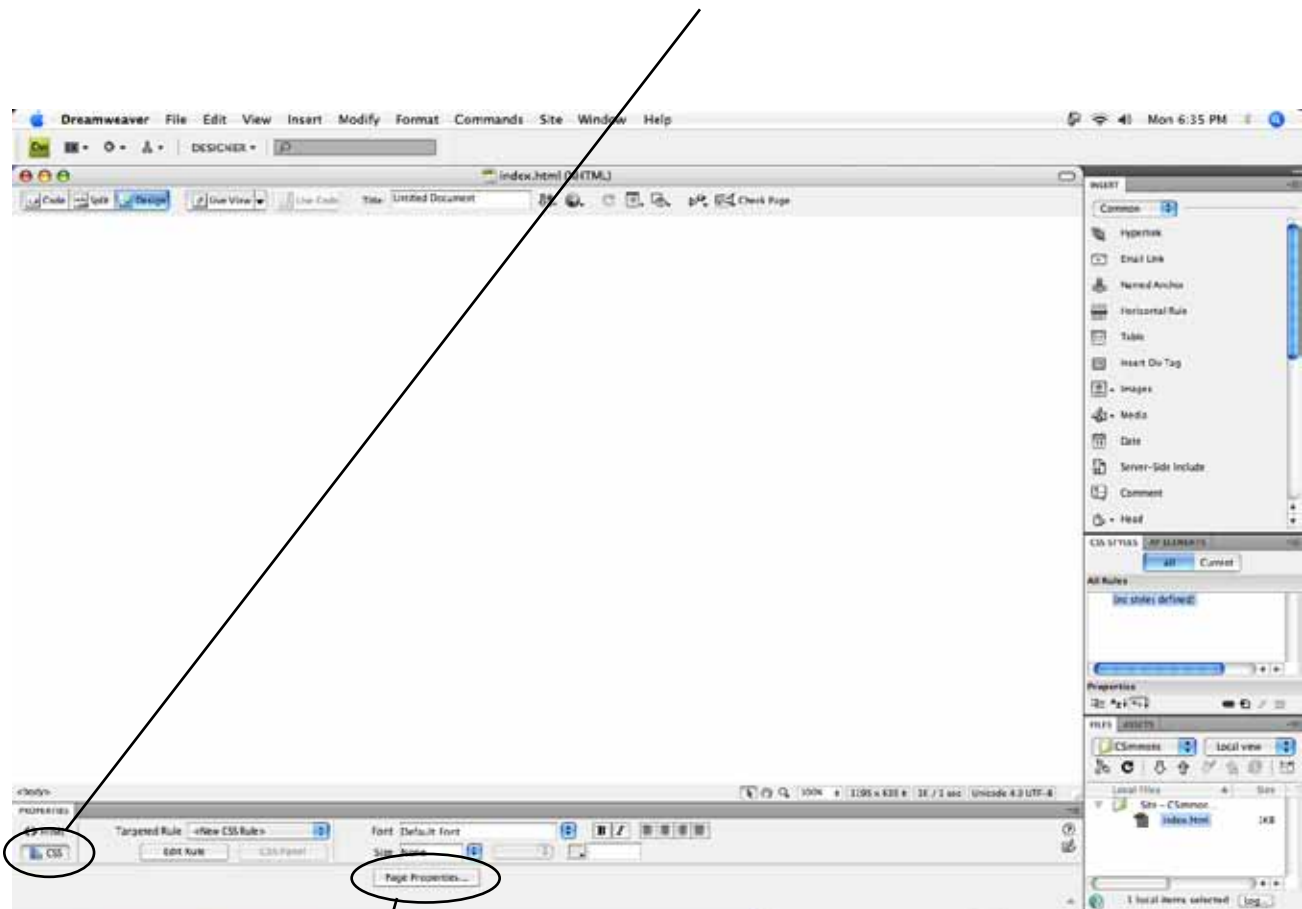
Setting Page Properties

In this guide you will learn how to:

- Choose a page's background color
- Choose the color of a page's text
- Choose the text color of a page's hyperlinks
- Set the font style of headings
- Title a Web page

STEP 1

To access the page properties menu, click on the CSS tab in the "properties" menu.

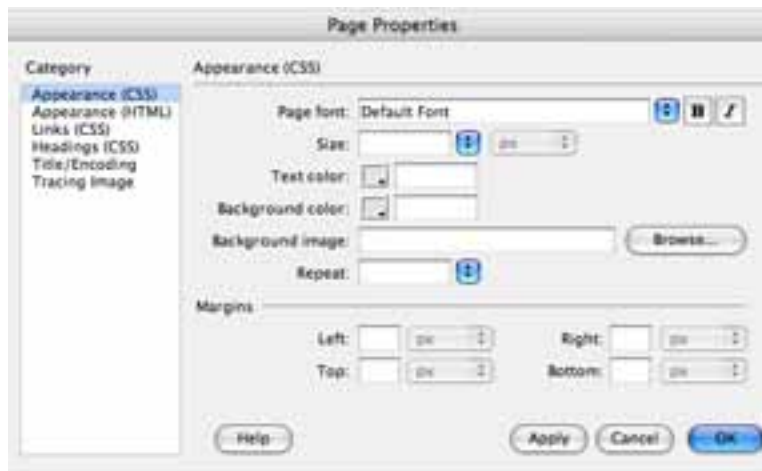


Then click on the "page properties" button. The page properties menu will pop up.

STEP 2

Select “**appearance (CSS)**” from the page properties menu on the left.

From this menu you can set the font for text on the page, the size of the font, the color of text, the background color of the page, and add margins to the four sides of the page.



STEP 3

Select “**links (CSS)**” from the page properties menu on the left.

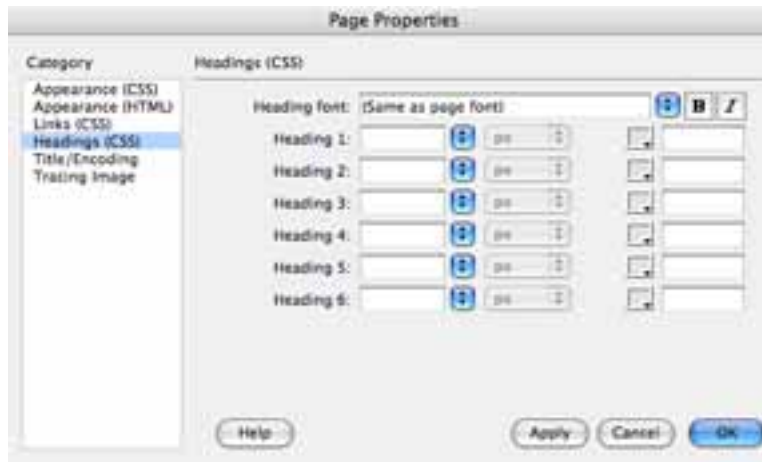
From this menu you can set the color of the links (regular, visited, rollover, and active), as well as specify font type and size for links.



STEP 4

Select “**headings (CSS)**” from the page properties menu on the left.

From this menu you can set the font style, size, and color of the six different headings (h1 - h6).



STEP 5

Select “**title encoding**” from the page properties menu on the left.

Fill in a title in the box next to “Title”.
