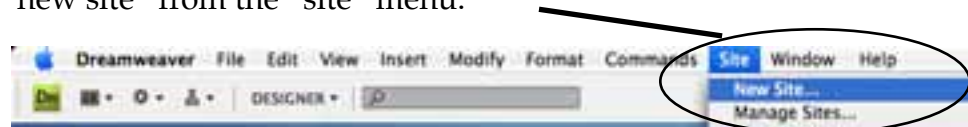
- Set up a site in Dreamweaver CS4

SETTING UP A SITE

Dreamweaver not only creates Web pages but it can also manage your entire site. When you create a site in Dreamweaver you can manage all the files in your site from one location.

Before you set up a site you'll need to create a folder to save your site in. Create the folder on your removable storage device (thumb drive, etc) and proceed with the following steps.

To create a site select "new site" from the "site" menu.



A wizard will appear to help you set up your site.

The wizard will now ask you a series of questions.

Enter a name for you site in the space provided.

Leave the http address area blank.

Click "next."



Next, answer “No, I do not want to use a server technology” and click next.



Select “edit local copies on my machine”.

Then click on the folder icon and browser/select the folder you have created on your portable storage device.



Select “none” from the drop down menu to answer the question “How do you connect to your remote server.”



When you get to the summary page click done.



MANAGING A SITE

Once you've created a site every time you open Dreamweaver the file manager will appear in the bottom right hand corner of your screen. From here you can manage the files (html pages, pictures, video clips, etc) contained in your site.
