- VI. MyMocsDegree Planner Updates – many of these errors will be resolved with the new face that should be up by August
 - a. ZK error during What If – comes from creating an entire plan and saving the whole thing at once. The issue is being worked on so save in increments until it sorts out.
 - b. Registration through planner is live for Fall 2019

- i. Students with multiple locked plans have the ability to register for individual courses from those plans, they are not lumped together.
- ii. When you are advising a student with a wild card/any course it will lead them to register for a co-op work experience. It may resolve with the upgrade but the work around for now is to be more specific with courses list specific options or a specific class.

- iii. Jessica Pierce- there are still 2 SSCI attributes can that be addressed?
 - 1. In the class schedule there are 2 Behavioral Social Science and Behavioral Social Science 2014 they need to search for the one without the 2014 which is different from all the other attributes
- iv. Banner team is working on reporting through MMD Planner; they have been asked to come share that and it should be in a month or so. There should be reporting that will come that will show when the last update to a student plan has been made and who has plans.
 - 1. This will be very helpful for class prediction

- a. Fall time ticket breakdown will be sent to Mary Beth and distributed soon
- b. UT Promise – stems from UTK and is similar to Knox Achieves
 - i. If students have remaining maintenance fees (not covering housing or meal plans) and make less than \$50,000 as a house hold as well as maintain TN HOPE requirements UT Promise will cover that remaining fee balance
 - ii. There is a community service and mentoring requirement – we will have more details coming on those later
 1. Will the mentoring opportunity be opened to members of the community as well at UTC staff/faculty?
 - a. We believe so, but more information and details will be forthcoming
- c. If you are having issues with Navigate (SSC Campus) and Brad Bond is out, you can reach out to Stacie to help get it resolved
 - i. We are moving Navigate (SSC Campus) to a web based training for new users. We will add lab time after the training video has been viewed.
- d. American History Requirement- a graduation requirement is that students have to have completed a unit of American History in high school or 6 credit hours of American History in college. Most US students have done this, but international and GED/non-traditional students often have not.
 - i. MyMocsDegree was flagging international students to meet this, but there were some that were not flagged. Students that are juniors and seniors who were not flagged and have not finished this requirement will be allowed to graduate without the requirement. If a student is a sophomore or freshman this requirement will be added.
 1. Communication will be sent out to advisors of those that have the deficiency added ii.

ii. Questions

- a. Jessica Pierce: With regards to the new funding model, because it will be listed as a deficiency on MMD will that allow it to be funded by the new funding model?
 - i. Yes, since it is picked up as needed from a financial aid perspective it will be funded.

 - i. Yes, refer any questions or concerns to Records
