- Fall Break Service Trip

- Extended Library Hours
 - Direct Response to student concern about access during exams
 - 24 hour access
 - 3 days during the exam period
 - High security involvement





Major Student Concerns

- Adequate Intramural Fields

 - Student Petition Generated that Colin street solution not conducive to needs
- Environmental Issues
 - E.D.G.E led campus in campaign for Recycling of waste and use of Clean Energy
 - Proposal of Clean Energy Fee to be put to Student Referendum Vote this upcoming April





Major Student Concerns

- Finalization of One-Stop Shop
 - Students **very eager to break ground** on the completion of the University Center
- Funding for New Library
 - Students interested in expressing concern with legislature
- Need / Desire for Greek Housing
 - Students pleased to hear that there is a strong possibility of this opportunity in the near future





Proposed Funding Projects

- Adoption of Annual Service Trip
 - Proactively meet the need for an overall Collegiate Experience by providing at least 1 **Major** service opportunity per school year
 - Collaboratively Sponsored
 - Become University Initiative
- Do MORE to improve Retention
 - Place Services of Student Success Center and Student Support Services together so that they may collectively have visibility on campus to students
 - To better meet needs
 - Grow to serve more students
 - Centralize services in appropriate high traffic area of U.C. to generate traffic and utilization of services.

- Centralization of Student Centers
 - Move forward in renovation of old student office space in U.C.
 - Creating Adequate environment for:

 - Women's Center
