SPECIAL POLICY FOR TOTALLY DISABLED AND/OR SENIOR CITIZEN ENROLLING IN CREDIT COURSES

In accordance with provisions of Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 49-3251, subsection (b), you may be enrolled in a course for academic credit without paying regular fees to The University of Tennessee at Chattanooga. You must make application for admission to the University, register for courses, meet the requirements of the class for specified grades, and have a permanent academic record maintained in the same manner as other students enrolled for credit.

Applicable admission fee to the university is required. A registration fee of seven dollars (\$7.00) per semester hour credit up to a maximum of seventy dollars (\$70.00) for any one semester is also required.

Text books and other class materials must be purchased by the student. Also you must pay for other special services (e.g., music fees, band deposits, laboratory fees, parking fees, program and service fees, technology fees, late registration charges, graduation fees, etc.) as they are appropriate to the course(s) you take or as these services may be desired by you.

The existence of permanent disability must be certified by a physician practicing in a medical specialty which would qualify him/her to judge the nature and extent of the disability, or from the agency charged with compensating the disabled person or adjudicating his/her permanent total disability.
