Multicultural Affairs

- **61%** increase in daily sign-ins for August 2017 as compared to August 2016
- **75%** increase in sign-ins for programs in the MCC for August 2017 as compared to August 2016
- **90.9%** 1-year retention rate for Fall 2015 Mentorship Cohort Group

Multicultural Affairs

- **75%** 2-year retention rate for Fall 2014 Mentorship Cohort group
- **44%** 5-year graduation rate for Fall 2011 Mentorship Cohort Group
- **22%** 4-year graduation rate for Fall 2012 Cohort Group
- **20%** Increase in budget for 2017-2018 term
