

Chemistry & Physics Advisement Program

We provide **academic advisement and career counseling** for **sophomore, junior, and senior students** who are majoring in Chemistry or Physics as indicated below. Prior to signing up for the next semester of classes, each student should schedule an advisement session where the advisor will discuss the student's course of study and give the student a PIN code for registration. This code changes each semester and students must talk with an academic advisor to receive it. Advisors will normally put up sign up sheets for Advisement times. Be on time for your appointment and bring a list of classes completed (such as MyMocs Degree list) and a list of what you expect to take in the next semester. To progress in your course work, you must look at the online catalog course descriptions so you can plan for the pre- and co-requisites requirements for your courses.

After initial summer orientation advisement through the department, then **freshman students** are assigned an advisor in the Center for Advisement and Student Success (CASS) in the University Center and will receive their PIN codes there.
