Subject: Health Insurance Marketplace Notice

The University of Tennessee campuses offer health insurance plans to undergraduate and graduate students. Each campus may have different eligibility criteria and varying premium/contribution rates. Some students, such as international students, are required to purchase health insurance.

In addition to the university offered plans, other personal health insurance plans, or coverage under your parents' plan, you may use the Health Insurance Marketplace to find insurance coverage that meets the requirements of the Affordable Care Act. In the Marketplace, you can compare plans based on price, benefits, quality, and other features important to you before you make a choice.
