The successful candidate should have a B.S. in Engineering from an ABET accredited program and a Ph.D. in Engineering Management or a closely related field giving him/her the ability to teach undergraduate and graduate courses across the Engineering Management & Technology curriculum. Applicants should have a proven experience or ability to provide instruction in a variety of modalities including online and a commitment to working with undergraduate and graduate students in research. Preference will be given to candidates with teaching and research interests in engineering management, construction management, manufacturing, mechatronics, and product development. Excellent communication and interpersonal skills, as well as the ability to motivate and inspire students are desired, along with the ability to develop a nationally and internationally recognized and funded research program.

The EMT Department (www.utc.edu/ENGM), part of the College of Engineering and Computer Science, offers an ABET-ETAC accredited B.S. degree in Engineering Technology Management with concentrations in Construction Management and Engineering Management and an M.S. degree in Engineering Management with concentrations in Engineering Management, Construction Management, and Power Systems Management.

Applications should include a cover letter, teaching and research statements, current curriculum vita, three letters of recommendation, unofficial transcripts, and the names, addresses, and telephone numbers of at least three references.
