

Mystery Competition

Overview

The Mystery Competition allows engineering students to display skills in problem solving, communication, and decision-making on a limited time schedule. The official rules will be disseminated at the time of the competition.

Objective

The objective of the Mystery Competition will be revealed in the official rules at the time of the competition.

Eligibility

Both graduate and undergraduate student members are eligible to participate.

Logistics

Each university may enter one (1) team consisting of up to four (4) participants. The team will report to the competition location at the specified time per the official conference program and schedule. No team shall have more than one (1) graduate student as a participant.

Submittals

No submittals are required.

Execution

The execution details of the Mystery Competition will be provided in the official rules presented at the time of the competition.

Judging

Scoring will be based on the team's performance on completing the assigned task(s).



Disqualifications

Any team actions deemed by the judges to be against the spirit of the competition will result in automatic disqualification from the competition. The phrase "against the spirit of the competition" will be defined on the official rules. Judge's decisions are final.
