

T-Shirt Competition

Overview

This competition allows teams to showcase their artistic ability, creativity and student involvement while incorporating the following T-shirt design criteria.

Objective

The T-shirt should embody the conference theme, “Innovations of the Past: Building Blocks for the Future” and embody university spirit.

Eligibility

Each university may have one entry for the T-shirt competition. There is no limit to the number of students that may participate. The team captain must be an undergraduate student.

Logistics

All teams are to include a brief written description of their design when submitting their T-shirt. The description is to be no more than 500 words. Both T-shirt and description will be presented to a three-judge panel simultaneously, only the T-shirt will be judged. Each description should include university name and theme as well as the names of the individuals who participated in the competition. The university name and participant names will not be counted against the maximum word count.

Submittals

Each university will submit one T-shirt and written description Thursday, March 19, 2015. Refer to the official conference schedule for location and time.



Execution

Execution of the T-Shirt Competition will consist of:

1. T-shirts may be any size and style.
2. T-shirts must be 100% cotton.
3. T-shirts MUST be screen printed (front, back, or both) and may use as many colors as desired; however, no embroidery is allowed.
4. The name of the competing university and theme must be prominently displayed on the design.
5. All questions regarding interpretation of the rules must be referred to the event coordinator who will be the authority on final decisions.

Judging

A three-judge panel will collectively rank the T-shirt designs based on the following categories:

1. Originality
2. Relevance to Civil Engineering and Theme
3. Artistic Quality and Aesthetics
4. Display of University Name and Theme

The written descriptions will be used to ensure clarity of design only.

Disqualifications

Teams not adhering to the regulations in execution section will be disqualified at the discretion of the judges.
