A Ph.D. is required and strongest consideration will be given to candidates with a strong record of scholarship in data science areas including machine learning, data-intensive analytics in smart cities and infrastructure sensing, data mining, unstructured data analysis, modeling and simulation, or predictive analytics. Experience applying this core knowledge to urban, medical and/or social science. Candidates must have proven experience or ability to provide instruction in a variety of modalities including online.
