 - Chattanooga Technology Council Scholarship: Applicants must submit an essay of 1000 words or less in order to demonstrate his/her drive, passion, and interest in the future of Engineering or Computer Science. This essay should address the need for the work in the field or the evolving national or global issues that the field is facing.
 - Information Systems Security Association Scholarship: Applicants should submit an essay of 1400 words or less in order to demonstrate his/her drive, passion, and interest in future IT research or area of desired future work in Information Security, Computer Engineering, or Computer Science. This essay should address the need for the work in the field or the evolving national or global issues that the field is facing.
