- Passionate about students and social justice
- Excellent interpersonal skills
- Those interested in teaching certifications in elementary grades, secondary math, or secondary science

ABOUT THE TEACHER RESIDENT POSITION:

Project Inspire teacher residents will be trained through a blend of graduate courses and an embedded apprenticeship in schools with highly effective mentor teachers lasting from June 2017 to July 2018. While serving in a classroom, teacher residents will assume more responsibility for the classroom as the year goes on all the while receiving specific, focused coaching and co-teaching support from the mentor teacher.

TO WHAT WILL PROJECT INSPIRE RESIDENTS COMMIT?

- '17-'18 academic year apprenticeship with a clinical instructor in an assigned Hamilton County School
- 14 months of integrated graduate courses leading to a Master's of Arts in Teaching
- 4 years of teaching in a high-need Hamilton County School post residency year

WHAT WILL PROJECT INSPIRE TEACHER RESIDENTS RECEIVE?

- Competitive living stipend during the 14 month residency year
- Master's of Arts in Teaching and teaching license conferred upon successful completion of the residency year; teacher residents receive tuition-free master's degree
- Rigorous, thoughtfully designed training program and supportive hiring process
- Tailored individual coaching for four years after residency year completion and network of support for beginning teachers
