
INTRAMURAL OFFICIAL

Job Summary:

Intramural Officials will be reponsible for safely and fairly maintaining game play. This position is primarily responsible for ensuring that intramural games are set up properly and run efficiently. Officials must understand rules of the sport and be able to make fair and unbiased judgements through play. All Intramural Assistants should demonstrate a commitment to the mission and core values of Campus Recreation.

Job Responsibilities:

- Begin each shift on time and prepared to work; this includes appropriate uniform and attitude
- Perform all required shift tasks, including opening/closing duties, with accuracy and efficiency.
- Be knowledgable about all Campus Recreation programming and be able to answer questions and direct patrons to correct locations.
- Consistently enforce all Campus Recreation policies, rules and regulations.
- Officiate intramural contests for various sports with other officials and intramural supervisors.
- Effectively communicate with fellow staff members, participants, and spectators in a positive manner and handle conflict as it rises.
- Maintain cleanliness of all Campus Recreation spaces and report any unsafe conditions requiring maintenance or attention.
- Maintain all required CPR/AED/FA and BBP certifications.
- Attend all trainings, meetings and events set forth at the beginning of the semester.
