

# Employment and Placement

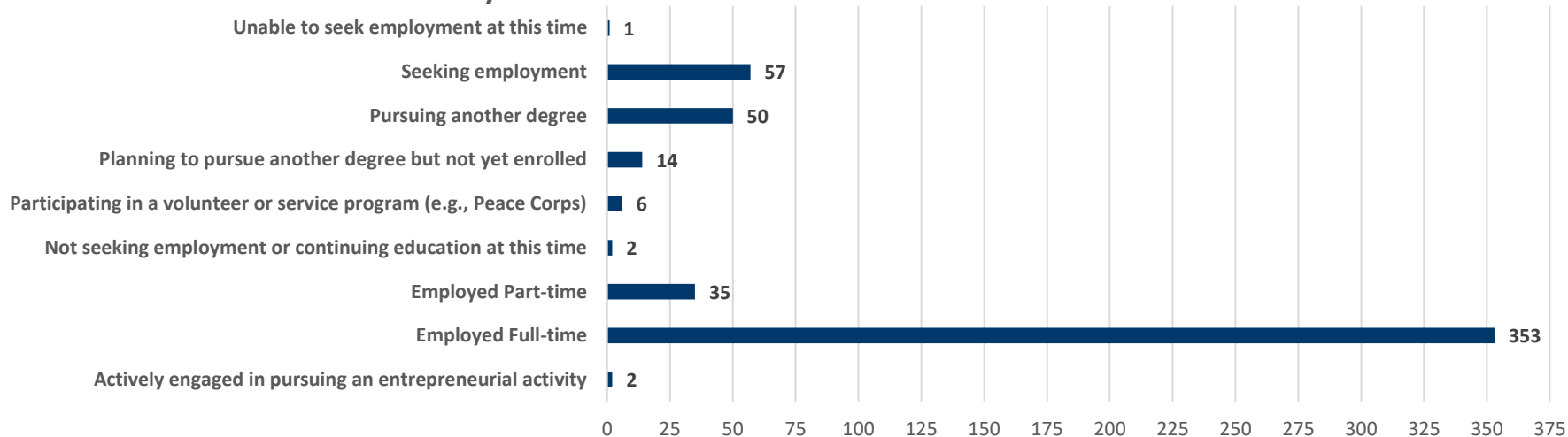
## Graduation Period: Summer 2017-Spring 2018

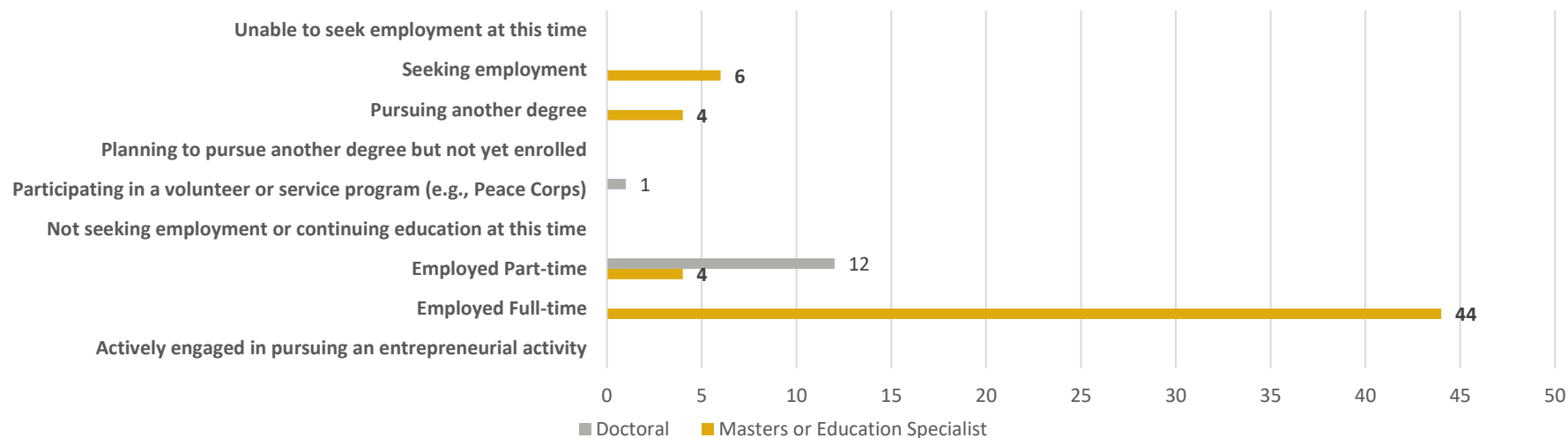

### Primary Status for Master's and Doctoral Students after Graduation

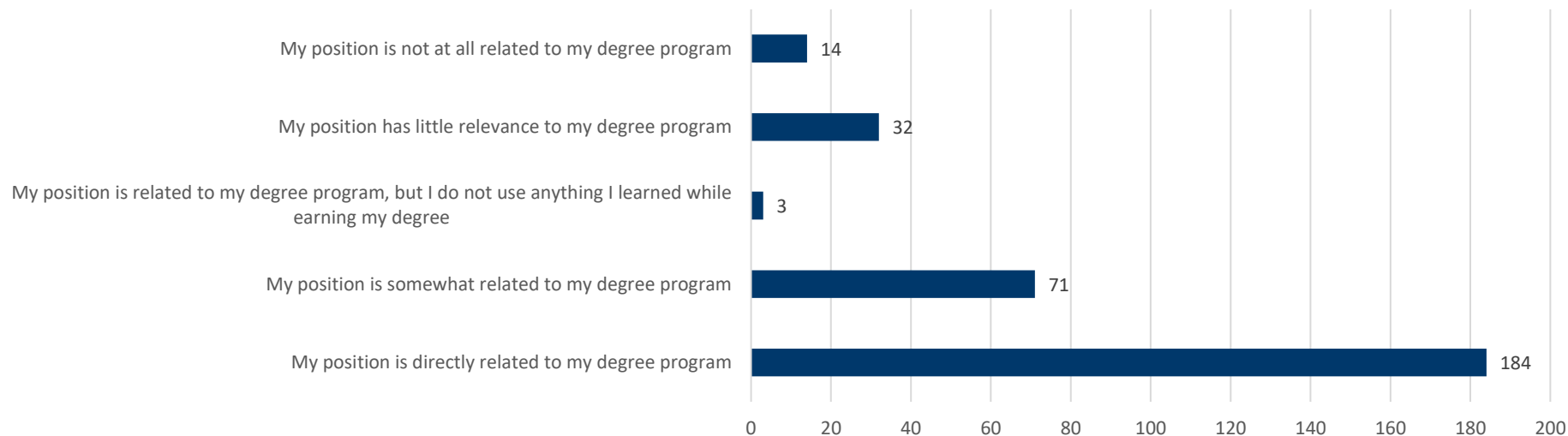

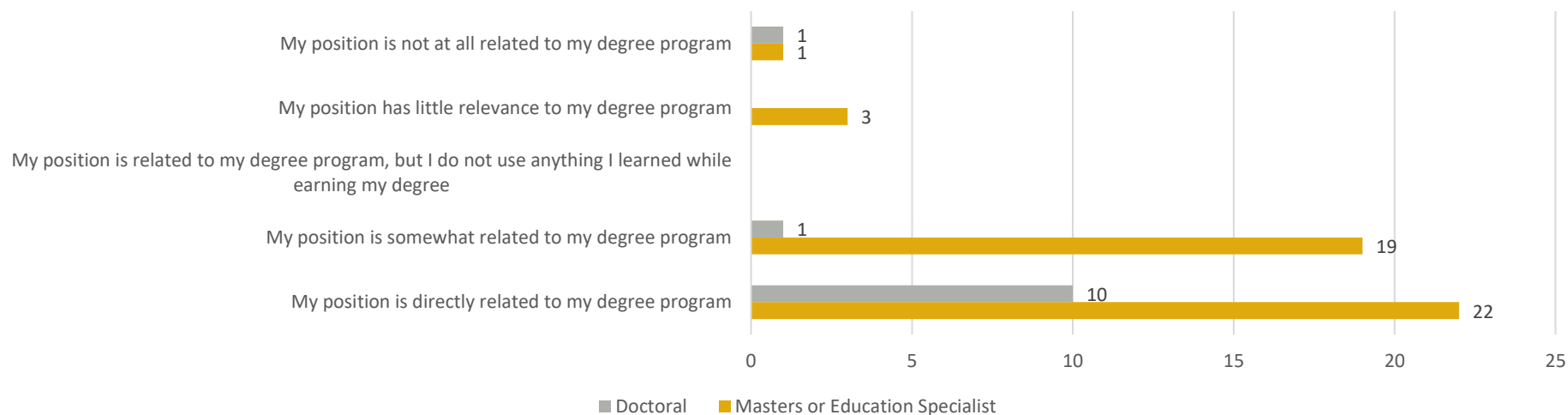

### Relevance of Job by Baccalaureate Degree Level



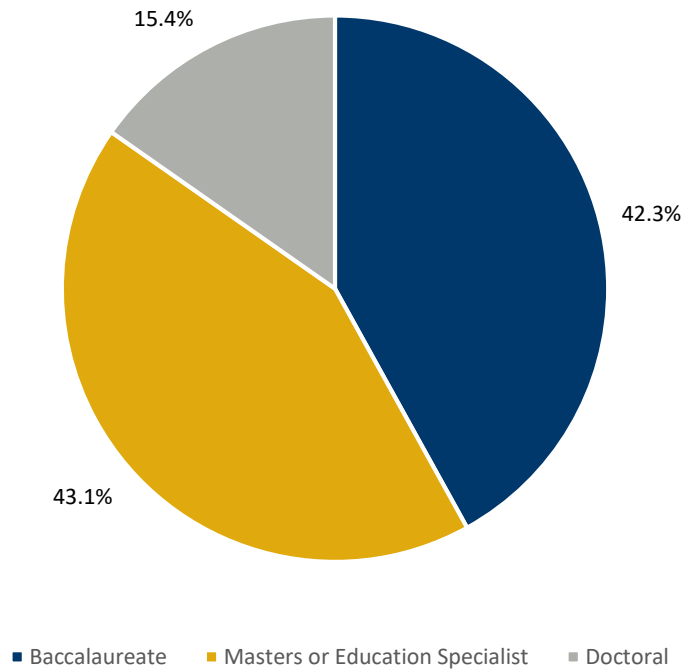
### Relevance of Job by Master's and Doctoral Degree Level

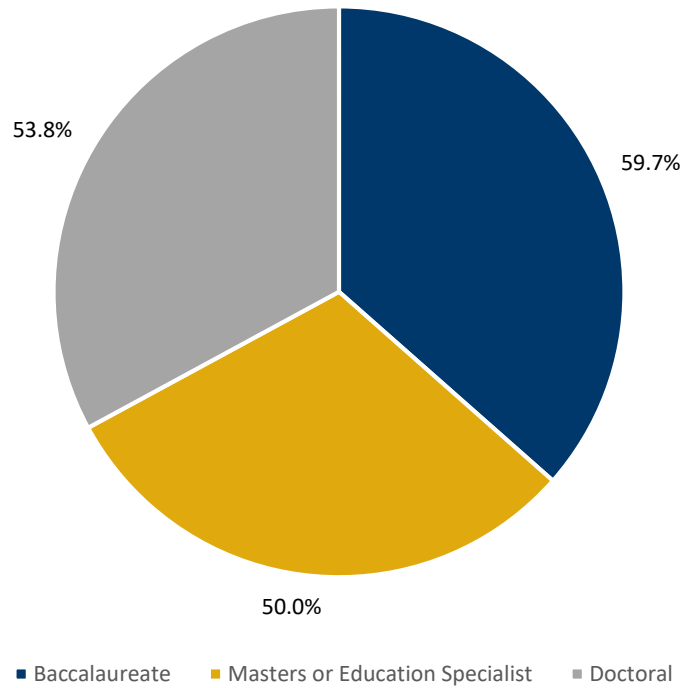
Graduates working in Chattanooga by Degree Level

Graduates working in Tennessee by Degree Level

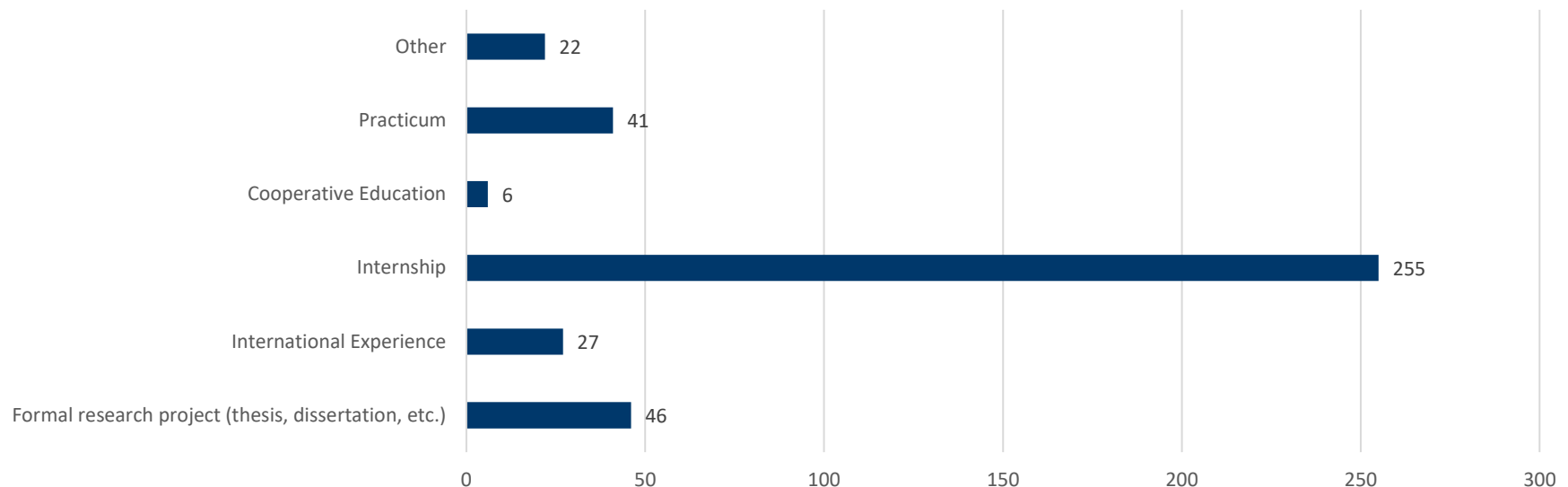
