Grading Form for Technical Papers

This tool can be used for students to evaluate other student's papers that follow a technical format, such as APA. This is a criteria-based form where points are assigned for each criteria.

Grading Form for Technical Papers

This form is similar to the Grading Form, but it has a more technical focus. The author of the two forms used them in conjunction to grade a two part project. The criteria in this form has a more technical focus.

 Title Page with a good descriptive title. (3 points)
 Abstract (summarizes study). (5 points)
 Introduction (12 points) Develops the background. Summarizes the relevant literature. States the specific purpose of the study. Demonstrates a logical connection between previous research and the study. Includes formal statements of hypothesis (es).
 Method (10 points) Participants (Tells who they were, gives specifics.) Materials (describes the equipment), Procedure (explained clearly)
 Results (5 points)
 References (adequate number of relevant sources) (5 points)
 Grammar, spelling, sentence construction (7 points)
 Format (followed format of sample paper) (3 points)
 Total (60 points)
