# UTC Dept. of Communication Assessment Responsibilities & Strategies

### **Collection and Reporting Responsibilities**

The Department Head is responsible for helping faculty refine assessment tools and establish and maintain submission processes and calendars.

Faculty who are teaching courses with outcomes selected for assessment are responsible for submitting data to the Department Head at least once during the academic year on a reporting cycle determined by faculty and the Department Head.

The Department Head is responsible for collecting, evaluating, and summarizing all assessment data and delivering the results each Fall to the faculty, who will "close the loop" by deciding on and implementing curriculum changes based on student outcomes.

The Department Head is also responsible for collecting, evaluating, and reporting on additional Indirect Assessment measures, such as retention/graduation statistics, alumni and graduating senior surveys, alumni tracking, and review of student awards.
