## **Definitions**

- 1. <u>CLINICAL CONTACT HOUR</u>: TENNESSEE BOARD OF SOCIAL WORKER LICENSURE" (FALL 2016) DEFINES CLINICAL EXPERIENCE AS, THE ASSESSMENT, EVALUATION, DIAGNOSIS, AND TREATMENT INVOLVING THE THERAPY PROCESS BASED ON THE PROFESSIONAL APPLICATION OF SOCIAL WORK KNOWLEDGE, VALUES, AND SKILLS" (P. 3). IN AN EFFORT, TO FAMILIARIZE STUDENTS WITH THIS LANGUAGE, CLINICAL CONTACT HOURS WILL BE DEFINED AS THOSE THAT FULFILL THE ABOVE DEFINITION. IN ORDER TO COUNT AS A CONTACT CLINICAL HOUR, THE STUDENT AND RECIPIENT OF SERVICES MUST MEET, AT MINIMUM, 45 MINUTES.
- 2. <u>Generalist</u>: "Generalist practitioners use a range of prevention and intervention methods in their practice with individuals, families, groups, organization, and communities. The generalist practitioner identifies with the social work profession and applies ethical principles and critical thinking in practice. Generalist practitioners incorporate diversity in their practice and advocate for human rights and social and economic justice" (CSWE, 2008, p.7). Examples include but are not limited to, case management, resource linkage, research, advocacy, and education.
- 3. CLINICAL GROUPS: THERAPY SESSIONS PROVIDED TO 2 OR MORE PERSON(S) AT THE SAME TIME.

4. CLINICAL INDIVIDUALS: THERAPY PROVIDED TO 1 PERSON FOR 45 MINUTES OR MORE, NOT TO EXCEED 1 HOUR.
