Proposed Change to the NTT Committee Description in Faculty Senate Bylaws

Current language:

Non-Tenure-Track Faculty Responsibilities. The Non-Tenure-Track Faculty Committee addresses the needs of non-tenure track faculty and brings their concerns to the attention of Senate and administration. It provides a communication channel between this part of the community and the university.

Composition. Four non-tenure-track full-time faculty with one member representing each academic college and four adjunct faculty, one from each academic college; ex officio: Provost Designee. Adjunct faculty members will be appointed no later than the second Senate meeting of the fall semester. The President-elect will ask the dean of each academic college to nominate an adjunct representative.

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Non-Tenure-Track Faculty Responsibilities. The Non-Tenure-Track Faculty Committee addresses the needs of non-tenure track faculty and brings their concerns to the attention of Senate and administration. It provides a communication channel between this part of the community and the university.

Composition. At least four non-tenure-track full-time faculty with one member representing each academic college and four adjunct faculty, one from each academic college; ex officio: Provost Designee. Adjunct faculty members will be appointed no later than the second Senate meeting of the fall semester. The President-elect will ask the dean of each academic college to nominate an adjunct representative.

Rationale:

This allows the NTT Committee to accept more members, providing greater support and a more manageable workload for its members.
