Sandy Zitkas: yes, this will retroactively apply to students. Melanie: MyMocsDegree should be ready May 1. Vikki Bernotski-When can students change major to new catalog/major? **CDA** (Rob Liddell): Hosted Hajoca recruiter spoke about their management development program. Training Committee did a short intro to career development. Major changes: Of students in SSC Campus, 30% changed 1 time, 11% 2 times, 3% 3+ times. Upcoming: May 9, 3pm and June 13, 3pm both in Raccoon Mountain Room. Peace Corp UTC alum in June 13 meeting. Nicole: Complete career assessment during orientation? Rob: Not pursued yet. Will take back to group to see about implementing this and not over-assess students. Targeting Undecided students with Center for Advisement.

**Update**: 15/4 tuition model: Proposal Passed (Stacie Grisham): BOT modified model approved 11% increase once hit 12 hours to encourage 15 hours. Will be implemented Fall 2019 with new students. Money should go to more courses, scholarships, advising, etc. to help with degree completion. If drop to 12 hours-no impact.
