Manage My Account

Go to My Account
View and pay your balance, authorize others to access your account, view your statements, and set up a payment plan or direct deposit for your refund.

View account summary and detail:

- Account Summary by Term**
Charges and payments to your account by term. This does NOT include estimated Financial Aid.
- Account Detail for Term**
Review detailed transactions on your account, including current and future balance totals for the selected term and other terms. This INCLUDES estimated Financial Aid.

Please note anticipated third party contract payments, financial aid, and memos are NOT included in Account Summary by Term.

Financial Aid

Do you have enough money to cover your costs?
Go to the Manage My Account channel and select Account Detail by Term. You can see the details of your Spring 2011 UTC bill and your estimated financial aid. Scroll to the very bottom to see if you still owe a balance after financial aid is applied towards your bill.

- If Current Due of Authorized Financial Aid and Memos is zero, your financial aid covers your UTC bill. If Account Balance Net of Authorized Financial Aid and Memos is a negative number, this is your credit balance after UTC tuition and fees and room and board charges have been paid.
- If Current Due of Authorized Financial Aid and Memos is a positive number, you owe a balance after financial aid is applied towards your account. You must pay this balance, or sign up for the installment plan (2 payments plus a \$20 installment plan fee) by December 17, 2010. If you feel you should not owe any money, check your financial aid awards to see if you have taken all steps to accept any loans offered to you.


